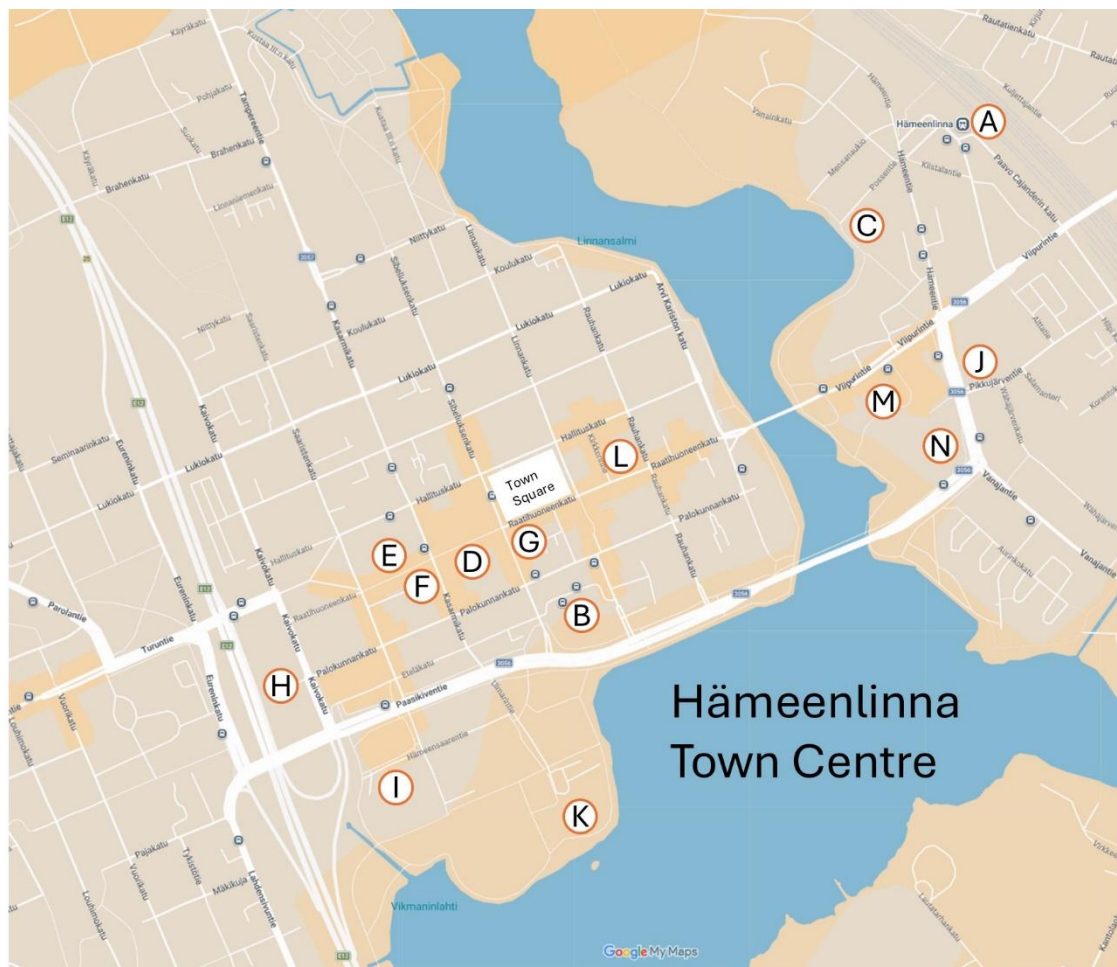


LITTLE SUNDAY GUIDE TO HÄMEENLINNA

Here is some information you might find useful if arriving to Hämeenlinna Sunday, 17.5.2026



Arriving and accommodation

You will most likely arrive by train at the railway station (A) or by bus at the coach station (B).

Hotels in the town centre include Sokos Hotel Vaakuna (C) near the railway station, as well as Hotel Emilia (D) and Hotel Scandic City (E) near the town square.

Eating

Most restaurants in Hämeenlinna are closed on Sundays. However, the following city centre restaurants are open (click the name to visit the website).

Casual Italian-inspired dining, open until 20:00.
- [Hamptown Bar & Kitchen \(F\), Raatihuoneenkatu 25:](#)
Premium burgers and modern comfort food, open until 21:00.

American diner style servings, open until 20:00.

For coffee, tea or pastries at the towns square:

Shops

Many stores close early on Sundays. For most shopping needs, [Goodman Shopping Centre \(H\)](#) is the best option – please check opening hours online.

Sports and other activities

- **Hämeenlinna Swimming Hall (K), Uimarinpolku 2:**
Our popular swimming hall is open to public on Sundays until 17:00. A single ticket costs 7,60 €.

This museum currently has an exhibition of historical photographs from Hämeenlinna. It is open on Sundays until 16:00.

International films are typically shown in the original language with Finnish subtitles; children's films are often available both dubbed and in the original language. Check the current films and screening times at the website.
