Workseed Guide 1/7 Login

After pressing the Log in button, do the following:

- 1. Click "M365 login"
- 2. Select "Universities of Applied Sciences"
- 3. Select "HAMK" from the drop-down menu

Log in with your HAMK credentials (username@student.hamk.fi). If you have already logged in to one of HAMK's systems with the same browser, the browser may log you in directly.









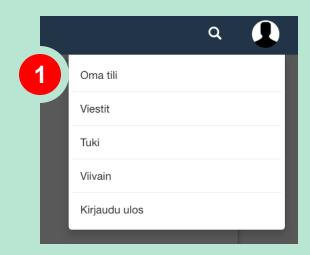
Workseed Guide 2/7 After Logging In

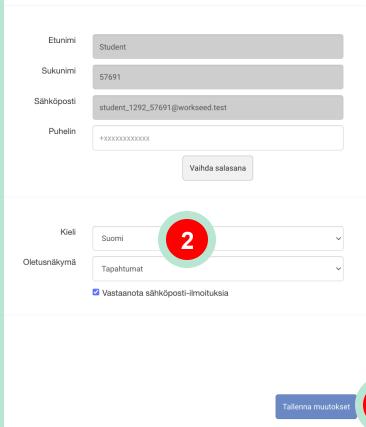
After logging in, you may have to change language to English. You can do this by clicking on the portrait figure in the upper right corner. This opens a menu where you need to select "Oma tili". (1)

In the following page, change the language in the dropdown menu titled "Kieli". (2)

Press "Tallenna muutokset" to save the language setting. (3)

After this, return to start page by clicking "Schedule" in the main menu.







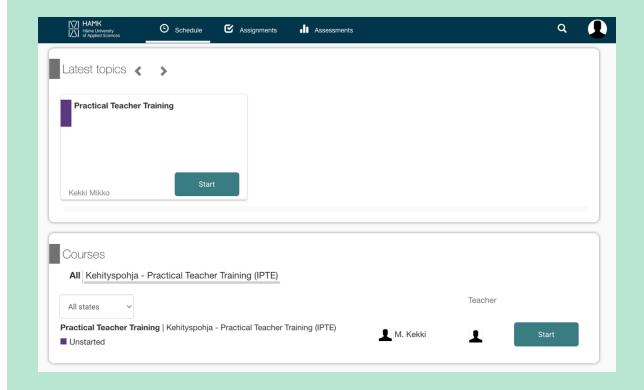


Workseed Guide 3/7 Schedule page

Now you'll be on the Schedule page. You can see the heading "Practical Teacher Training" in two places.

You can start the teacher training procedures by clicking either of the Start buttons.

After starting, the Start button changes to the Continue button. Otherwise, the outlook remains the same.







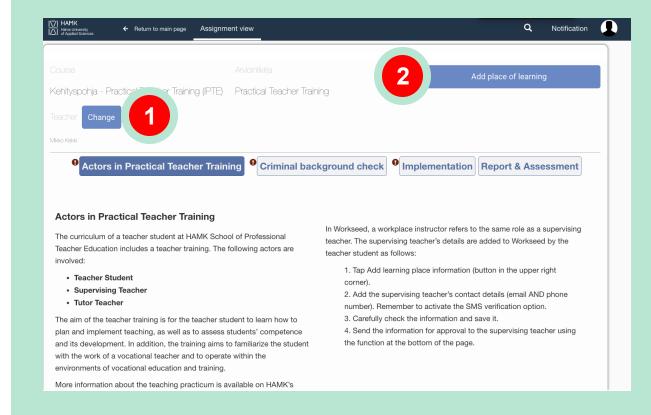
Workseed instruction 4/7 Working view

After pressing the Start button, you will find instructions on how to proceed, fill in information and complete activities.

As a first step, change your teacher to the tutor teacher in charge of your own group.

This is done by clicking the Change button (1) at the top left of the page. Clicking on it will open a drop-down menu from which you can select your tutor teacher.

In the upper right corner, there is a button "Add place of learning" (2). Through it, you can add your supervising teacher's information to the system and enable them to access your Workseed content.

Add the information of the teacher supervising your training to the form that opens. Fill in the information marked as optional also.

Don't change the information under the "Further details" heading.

Finally, press Save and close.

The supervising teacher will then receive an email with instructions and a link to log in.

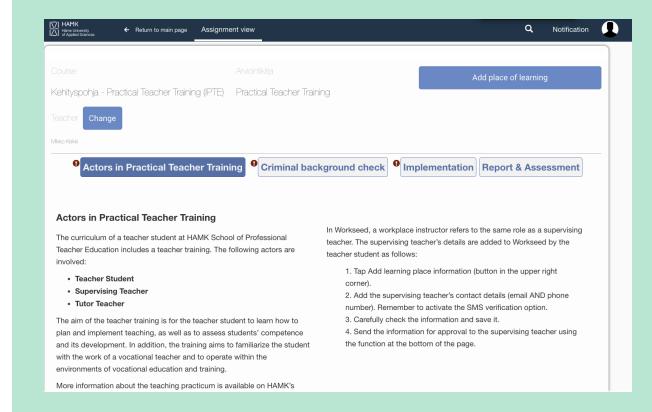
